

North Whins Proposal D - 50 Acres

Summary Proposal

That the "50 acres" or so currently owned by Duneland and situated just to the North of the High Dune Ridge are set aside for joint use by humans and Nature Beings.

How it would work

There are various government options on the human side including:

- Governance by Newlands.
- Resale to the Foundation
- Sale to another organisation
- Grant to the Findhorn Dunes Trust.

The main issue is that they give a life time commitment to supporting the co-creation process.

Co-creative Management

This is all subject to the desires of the Nature Beings who would participate fully in co-creation.

For example:

- An example of joint working would be for the humans to clear a fire barrier, since we are probably better at earth moving, whilst they would be better at plant farming.
- Management of the agreement would be achieved through a Circle with Attunments.

Much is being achieved by the Findhorn Hinterland Group, and this might provide a model for future development

The whole area forms a natural amphitheatre, with many nooks and crannies.
It is further away from The Park than the Hidden Valley and that might give a welcome distance.
